Call to Order: Stacy Zeller called the meeting to order at 7:08 PM

Uniform Turn In:

There are still about 12 uniforms that have NOT been turned back in. The students will need them for the St. Patrick's Parade in Sellersville (more info below). Guard is not using them, since their theme is purple. Someone asked if the PMA pays for the indoor uniforms – No, individuals pay or can use points.

Indoor Show:

February 18, 2017 – start time 1:00 PM; Amy Wayland and Stacy Zeller will coordinate. Mike Eberhardt will be there to help. Kayan might be doing concessions. Albert from Integri-tees will be available to sell shirts. Shelly will call the water ice guy. We need someone to do the buttons.

Jazz at Pennridge/Jazz on the Ridge:

March 2 and 3, 2017. Julie Reed will run JOTR since no one else stepped up. Wanda will still help out. We will have water, pretzels, and candy for Jazz at Pennridge. Kayan will run concessions for JOTR. Julie will check with Kevin about a jazz show shirt. Other Spirit wear items could be sold during Jazz at Pennridge.

Philadelphia Soul Game:

Scheduled for Saturday May 13th which is Military Appreciation Night again. Other options were April 29th which is Jazz Championships, June 10th which is too close to graduation, and May 20th. Corinne is very supportive and wants us back. We have 250 tickets to sell. We will work out seating later – chaperones were not easily accessible last year. Students will wear the RWB bandanas again. Kevin will try to encourage the middle schools to come. Ticket prices will be same as last year: \$20 for Marching Band students, \$25 for all other students, \$30 for adults. Everyone must have a ticket. Middle school students would need to come with a parent, we are not bussing them. We could look into a "spectator bus" if there are enough people.

Fundraising:

- Giant Cards – available through Wanda. For every \$100 your student gets \$5. Can also get other denominations.
- Landis Cards – available through Julie Caporaletti – same \$100 and your student gets \$5

Landis Hoagie coupons – sold 378 coupons and order was placed yesterday. It should only take a couple of days. Vicki will send out an email when coupons are available for pickup.

Cherrydale Farms Soup & Cookies starts today. Orders and money is due January 31st. Pick up will be the end of February.

This is the LAST fundraiser before Disney.
